# PASTOR'S Report

"Life is difficult." How's that for an encouraging start to an annual report. It's how M. Scott Peck began his book, The Road Less Travelled: A New Psychology of Love, Traditional Values and Spiritual Growth. If we are honest, there are lots of times when we have to agree. Life is difficult. In the words of country singer Lynn Anderson, "I never promised you a rose garden" (some of you are thinking, "What's wrong - Pastor Mike is quoting a country music artist!")

We need to remember that life is difficult, because even if you, personally, are not facing a difficult time in your life at this moment, many of the people you meet every day are. People who..

- are facing surgery or are recovering from surgery;
- have family members in hospital;
- are unemployed or underemployed or facing uncertainty in their job;
- are making decisions about schooling or what happens after school;
- lack access to affordable housing;
- lack access to nutritious food;
- have physical handicaps and limitations;
- wrestle with mental health issues;
- face the stigma of mental health concerns;
- feel rejected by people...for whatever reason(s);
- feel ostracized because they have had an abortion;
- know the pain of abuse;
- have been pushed aside by others;
- ... the list goes on.

One of our worship leaders (Mark) said that one of the good things about OCC is that "we're not slick." That's good, because "slick" means that those who live lives that are difficult won't be able to find a home; "slick" is all about appearances, about looking good. The Gospel of Jesus has to do with being real. Here at OCC we are about being who God wants us to grow into – the likeness of Jesus.

What does this look like? On page 3 there is a summary of our Core Values. These are things that shape and drive ministry at OCC.

- We are about the TRUTH of who Jesus is and living out the MEANING that is rooted in him in a way that this generation can understand.
- We are about growing in our understanding of the BEAUTY of the creator God that gives rise to WORSHIP.

- We are about learning to live in AUTHENTIC COMMUNITY, learning to live out the truth of being the people of God.
- We are a people on a MISSIONAL JOURNEY. Our faith, this relationship with Jesus that we celebrate, takes us outside our comfort zones and moves us into our neighbourhoods.

You'll see some numbers later in this report that highlight the many people who serve, in a variety of ways at OCC. Some of these roles are visible, some are behind the scenes, but all are important and make a difference. There are a couple of groups of people I want to highlight.

- One is our Leadership Team, or based on the book we have been reading and studying together over the last few months, – our UNleader Team (you'll have to ask one of them about it). Thank you to John A., Tony A., Stan C., Alan J., Glenn G., Ryan L., Dan S. and Mark F. for your faithful, prayerful service and ministry.
- Second is our staff. Melanie does an wonderful job keeping our building clean. And some weeks it is big job – just don't mention the word "sparkles" to her. Thank you Melanie. And then there is Brenda. This report is full of her creative handiwork. She does an amazing job with scheduling and organizing. And it is all done with such an infectious joy. Thank you to both of you.

OCC is people who are growing in a passion for all of whom God is: Father, Son and Spirit. This is one of the reasons we don't call people who are part of OCC members – we are partners (see page 4 for more on partnership) together in the ministry Jesus calls us to, equips us for, sends us out into, and, walks with us in by his Spirit. It doesn't matter our age, our gender, our role, our title, our giftedness – what matters is that we are listening and walking with God. This includes rejoicing with those who rejoice and weeping with those who weep. This means we always learning (often making mistakes, but that's okay, if we are learning and making new mistakes), making room for those who feel like they are on the outside, drawing them in, helping them to find hope and forgiveness and grace and love in Jesus.

We're not perfect. We never will be. We're not slick. We have no intention of ever being that. We simply want to be faithful and real.


