HANGOUT [Warming Up to the Topic]

1. On December 1 we will be launching an incredible new Christmas series and celebrating the Grand Opening of the expansion of the site. We're taking the month to prepare our hearts and respond in action!
 - a. Take 5 minutes to individually identify 5-10 people that you could invite out to the Christmas series. Share ideas of how you'll share and brainstorm strategies in letting people know about our new series.
 - b. Now, take 5 minutes to text or email them (maybe even call them!). Or, if your strategy includes dropping a postcard off, pull out your calendar and schedule it in. If you use Facebook, why not "like the event" on Facebook and then invite others to the event, or post on your wall, change your profile pic...do something to spread the word!

HEAR [Listening to God through Scripture]

2. Read **John 2:13-25**.
 - a. What verse or idea from the text (or Sunday's message) stands out to you? Why?
 - b. What do you think is the significance of these events happening during the celebration of Passover?
 - c. What is the problem listed in **verse 14** that causes Christ's action in **verse 15**? Talk about why that was a problem (see **Mark 11:17** for a clue). Why is this so unacceptable to Jesus?
 - d. Jesus refers to his own body as the Temple. What characteristics and functions of the Temple is Jesus saying are now found in him?
 - e. Why wouldn't Jesus trust some of the people who trusted in him?
 - f. Some people raise the Temple cleansing story as a reason for not living out the peace teachings of Jesus. Their line of reasoning runs: "This story shows that Jesus wasn't a pacifist, so we can't expect his followers to be either." How would you respond to this idea?

HUDDLE [Making It Personal and Praying Together]

3. Your body as an individual is God's Temple. If Jesus came to cleanse this temple today, what do you think he would want to drive out?
4. You are one living stone together with other Christians that make up God's temple. If Jesus came to cleanse this temple today, the temple of your relationships with other believers, what do you think he would want to change?
