# **Quick Wins:**

- Use tools like Living Water's resources (water.cc) to educate your church about global poverty and water access.
- Launch a short campaign to raise funds for a water project or similar initiative. (<u>Such as Advent Conspiracy.</u>)
- Organize a community event or walk-a-thon to build awareness and support.

# **Long-Term Goals:**

- Establish a partnership with Living Water International to sponsor a WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) program area.
- Create a missions plan that integrates global poverty initiatives into your church's yearly goals.
- Develop discipleship pathways that include serving and learning opportunities related to poverty alleviation.
